Microtransit: Multi-passenger transportation service that serves passengers using

dynamically generated routes. It is a form of on-demand service.

Comingle: Operation of transit services in conjunction with each other. For the City

it would include incorporating Shuttle, Dial-a-Ride, MicroTransit, and

Metro options.

ADA: The Americans with Disabilities Act is a civil rights law that prohibits

discrimination based on disability.

Title VI: Title VI prohibits discrimination in any program or activity that receives

Federal funds or other Federal financial assistance. Calabasas Transit is currently in compliance of Title VI and must remain in compliance

when implementing new programs.

WAV: Wheelchair Accessible Vehicles are necessary to remain in compliance

with ADA and Title VI.

EV: Electric Vehicle, powered by a battery which gets recharged by plugging

into the electrical grid.

ZEV: Zero-Emission Vehicle

Software: Software may include programmed scheduling and dispatching, fare

collection, a smartphone app, and more.

Turnkey: A combination of software and physical vehicles being provided.

LSV: Low-Speed Vehicles, per California Vehicle Code, are only operable on

streets with a speed limit of 35 mph and lower.
