- 3. Director Green gave an update on the Community Center Roof repairs which are on track to finish in late August or early September. The Agoura Hills Calabasas Community Center Joint Powers Authority received a grant in total of \$1,010,000 for the roof project. Director Green suggested going online to see the time lapse of the roof repairs. The City of Agoura Hills received a federal earmark grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 for upgrades and infrastructure improvements. The City of Agoura Hills decided to use a general contractor. It will go out to bid in the next few weeks. Currently the Community Center is anticipated to reopen in January. Director Green gave an update on staffing needs and the hiring of new staff members.
