**SUBJECT:** COMMUNICATION WITH THE LAS VIRGENES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT - UPDATE

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:**

At the last Library Commission meeting, Commission Members asked me to communicate further with the Las Virgenes Unified School District (LVUSD) staff concerning the elimination of resources due to the loss of Hidden Hills' funds. I spoke to Cristina (Tina) Johnson, the LVUSD Coordinator of Libraries, Career Education & Outreach and reiterated the changes. I told her we were concerned that the school district did not publicly support the continuation of the MOU but we still wanted to continue our relationship. I assured her that most of the databases would be available to students until next Spring I suggested that all Kindergarten classes come to the Library for a field trip where we could provide them with regular library cards. We agreed to keep our communication lines open and work together to provide the greatest benefit for all students.
