#### II. NOTEWORTHY INCIDENTS

A resident of Calabasas was arrested for residential burglary on Park Miramar. The suspect (victim's son) made entry into the home after being arrested twice for trespassing at the location, there were no signs of forced entry. (23-04471)

A residential burglary occurred on Park Casino. Video surveillance footage showed four suspects in the rear yard of the residence. A rear sliding glass door was shattered to make entry. A Long Beach resident was arrested for the burglary; the remaining three suspects were able to evade capture. (23-04169)

A transient was arrested for a theft, which was reported on Mulholland Highway. The suspect made entry, selected store items, placed the items in shopping bags, and exited without paying. (23-04218)

Three incidents involving thefts of wallets were reported this month. The incidents occurred on Commons Way and Mulholland Highway. The victims were shopping at the locations, and when they went to pay for their groceries, they noticed their wallets were stolen from their purses.

In one incident, video surveillance footage showed a female distracting the victim while another female stole the victim's wallet.

The victims' stolen credit/debit cards were used at Costco, Target, and Walmart. (23-04497, 23-04499, 23-04555)

#### LOST HILLS JUVENILE INTERVENTION UNIT ACTIVITY REPORT FOR AUGUST 2023 CALABASAS

#### SCHOOL ISSUES

- Assisted Calabasas High School regarding a student with a restraining order against another Calabasas HS enrolled student.
- Conducted safety walkthroughs at Calabasas High School, Round Meadow Elementary, Muse School, Willow Elementary, AE Wright Middle School, AC Stelle Middle School, Mesivta, and Lupin Hill Elementary.
- Conducted Critical Scenario with staff members at AC Stelle Middle School, Bay Laurel Elementary, Muse School, Calabasas High School,
- Coordinated with Asst. Principal Lee at Calabasas HS for a special presentation hosted by Captain Seetoo and Lost Hills Station regarding fire safety.

#### INTERVENTIONS

#### **COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES**

- 1. We spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question various juvenile concerns and issues in the community. We also provide the parents with resource programs within our community.
- 2. We inquired with the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney regarding the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- 3. Met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo throughout the month to keep her up to date regarding our unit's investigations and current juvenile issues within our city.
- 4. Entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion Program for various violations.
- 5. We investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office. We additionally assisted other investigators in the preparation of their cases for court.
- 6. Met with station narcotic detectives to exchange information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
- 7. Handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals brought to the attention of this unit for various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel.
- 8. Conducted our normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- 9. Assisted patrol regarding CARP, backfill behind patrol/shortage, and mandatory overtime.
- 10. Participated in a school safety seminar hosted by the Joint Regional Intelligence Center at Azusa Pacific University.
- 11. Assisted Calabasas High School regarding security/crowd control at football games.
- 12. We attended a city council meeting for the City of Calabasas.
