

Mulholland Highway corridor Phase III project improved traffic safety along the corridor in the following ways:

- Corridor Traffic Calming:
 Narrow traffic lanes are to help reduce vehicular speed.
- Intersection Safety Improvements:

 Safety improvements at the intersection are achieved by narrowing of the traffic lanes. The signing and striping segregates the modes of transportation and helps minimizing conflicts between them.
- School drop-off area improvement:
 Drop-off/Pick-up area is separated from through traffic.
- Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements
 Replacing the asphalt shoulder areas
 that were used illegally as passing lanes
 with landscaped shoulders.
- Landscaping Improvements

Prior to project (2010-2015):

- 4 collisions resulted in injuries
- 2 injury collision involving pedestrians
- Post-project (2016-2023):
 - 2 collisions resulted in injuries
 - 0 collisions involving pedestrians
