MAYOR'S YOUTH COUNCIL (MYC) GUIDELINES FOR REGULAR AND SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Mayor's Youth Council makes recommendations to the City Council on matters of interest to young people in the community and works together to do the following:

- a. Help young people understand, appreciate, and participate in the workings of their local government;
- b. Help young people register to vote;
- c. Establish a rapport between students and student governments in the City's schools and the City and wider community; and
- d. Work with other youth councils across the United States.

Eligibility

Each Member of the Mayor's Youth Council must be a resident of the City of Calabasas between the ages of 14 and 21 years old.

Appointment and Term of Office

The Mayor will appoint up to 20 members for a term of two years. The commencement date of a Member of the Mayor's Youth Council's term is the date of appointment by the Mayor. The Mayor may remove any member from the Mayor's Youth Council with or without cause.

Organization

Members of the Mayor's Youth Council will elect a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Secretary from among their membership. The Chairperson will lead meetings. The Vice Chairperson will lead meetings in the Chairperson's absence. The Secretary will record and report the actions and votes of the Mayor's Youth Council.

Responsibilities:

The effectiveness of the Mayor's Youth Council depends upon the regular attendance of the members at meetings.

- 1. Members must be fully committed and engaged with/to the MYC.
- 2. Attendance is mandatory at monthly meetings of the MYC. MYC members may be removed prior to expiration of their term when that member has three unexcused absences within a calendar year. Excused

- absences will be granted provided members notify the City Clerk three days prior to a meeting stating the reason for the absence.
- 3. The MYC will not hold meetings during the summer break, June-August.
- 4. Attendance to a minimum of four MYC sponsored events is mandatory for all members, with the exception of MYC Officers who are required to participate on all MYC events unless excused. It is understood that the summer months may be difficult for some due to vacation.
- 5. Members who are unable to continue their service for reasons such as change of residency outside the City or personal reasons should submit a resignation to the City Clerk.
- 6. MYC members are encouraged to attend at least one Council meeting during the year.
- 7. MYC members may also be asked to assist the Mayor with various assignments, attend meetings or participate in a focus group on various topics. Participation in these additional events is voluntary.
- 8. Applications from MYC prospective members must be typed, include a 100-word statement as to planned involvement and be sent from the applicant's own email address and include their own cell phone number.
- 9. Every January, a notification will be sent for continuing and new members seeking interest in officer positions: Chair, Vice Chair or Secretary. A 200-word statement will be required stating why the interest in such position. Once statements are received, a ballot will be sent to all members to request they vote for Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary. Those selected will be appointed at the first meeting in February.
- After the election of officers, members will be encouraged to submit an interest card to lead a subcommittee. An interest card along with a 100-word statement will be required from those applying.
- Applicants who are not selected for an MYC seat, will be encouraged to join a subcommittee. An interest card will be provided to select a subcommittee.
- 12. All MYC members are required to respond to all written communication in a timely manner.
- 13. All MYC members will be required to sign in at all meetings and events.
- 14. Failure to adhere to these Guidelines will be cause fore removal from the MYC.
