





# REAL-TIME CRIME AND DISASTER CENTER



## What is a Real-Time Crime and Disaster Center?

Real-Time Crime and Disaster Centers serve as a hub for information and intelligence gathering, analysis, and dissemination, helping to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of law enforcement response and promoting public safety. By leveraging technology and data-driven strategies, RTCDCs support law enforcement agencies in making more informed decisions, optimizing resources, and enhancing collaboration across various public safety stakeholders.









### INTEGRATED REAL-TIME CAMERA FEEDS

- Ingest any public or private video network into a single platform
- Overlay Artificial Intelligence on existing camera feed
- Live streaming video feeds directly to dispatch or deputies in the field





## PRIVATE CAMERA REGISTRY

Enables citizens to partner directly with the Sheriff's Department by registering the locations of their cameras. Once camera registration is complete, Investigators can easily locate all the cameras in the vicinity of an incident via the map and contact the camera owner(s) directly to request footage.





## **UAS INTEGRATION**


Track and manage drone deployments. Live stream video to station or command post.



#### **How to Start a Neighborhood Watch Group** in 5 Easy Steps

1. Recruit and Organize as many neighbors as possible

It is wonderful that you are taking the steps to start a Neighborhood Watch group in your neighborhood. The first step is talking to your fellow neighbors about starting a group.

2. Contact your local law enforcement agency and schedule a meeting

The next step is contacting your local law enforcement agency. Invite them to meet with your group at a time and place convenient for your Watch Group. It is essential for your group to work in collaboration with law enforcement because Neighborhood Watch is a cooperative effort.

3. Discuss community concerns and develop an action plan

If law enforcement is unavailable to come to the first meeting you might want to have a meeting to discuss the concerns and issues in the neighborhood. Your group should create a plan on how to work towards lessening the impact of the top 3 concerns of neighbors.

4. Create a communication plan

It is important to decide what type of communication will work for your watch group - meetings or social media or both.

5. Take Action: Hold Meetings and Events

Neighborhood Watch Toolkit has a number of wonderful training topics and meeting ideas that can be useful to your group.




#### Recent string of celebrity home burglaries linked to social media posts

LAPD said. "Initially, it was believed that the homes were being burglarized at random. Detectives learned, however, that this wasn't the case. The victims' homes had been selected based on social media posting, touring or travel schedules of the owners." - ABCNews.com

#### 20 arrested for burglaries targeting homes across Orange County

A 13-month investigation resulted in the arrest of five juveniles and 15 adult suspects. The crime ring is responsible for at least 34 residential burglaries in Orange County, authorities said. The burglars would reportedly monitor social media posts and messages to determine when residents in upscale homes were gone. - KTLA 5 News








## KNOW YOUR EMERGENCY EVACUATION ZONE






