Review Item(s):

2. File No. APR-2023-017, MSCP-2023-003 and ZCL-2023-261: Requests for an Administrative Plan Review, Minor Scenic Corridor Permit, and Zoning Clearance for a proposed 1,057 sq. ft. Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU), trellis, and sports court which includes 8' high sport court fencing on a property with a previously approved 8,447 sq. ft. single-family residence with a 578 sq. ft. detached cabana, pool, spa, hardscape and landscape improvements currently under construction, located at 24101 Dry Canyon Cold Creek Road (APN: 4455-006-035) within the Rural Residential (RR) zoning district, and Scenic Corridor (-SC) overlay zone. The project was initially approved by the Planning Commission on September 6, 2018 via Planning Commission Resolution No. 2018-671, and subsequently modified via Planning Commission Resolution No. 2022-740.

Planner Rackerby gave an overview and explained the project had previously been approved, but that the scenic corridor issues required the project to come back a second time.

More information on the project was provided by Alexis Benavidez, who spoke on behalf of the Applicant, Architect Ken Stockton.

The ARP requested the Applicant to address the following concerns:

- 1. Landscape: provide additional landscaping to screen the ADU
- 2. Windows on elevations: Fix the proportions of the frames
- 3. Screen the mechanical equipment and depict the equipment on the plans. If the equipment is to be located on the roof, provide screening in a non-reflective color.
- 4. Sports court netting to blend with earth tones
- 5. Sports court materials to blend with earth tones
- 6. ADU stucco to blend better with the environment: consider a darker gray tone
- 7. Provide a physical materials board

Following discussion on the project, Acting Chair Mugrdechian-Armen moved to continue the item to the next meeting of the ARP, to allow the Applicant time to address the concerns of the ARP. Panel member Dabach, seconded the motion.
