## Review Item(s):

2. <u>File No: SPR 2024-002:</u> Request for a Site Plan Review for construction of a new 3,576 SF addition to first and second floors of an existing two-story single-family residence located at 25202 Prado del Grandioso (APN: 2069-090-028) within the Residential Single-Family (RS) zoning district.

Associate Planner Hayes provided an overview of the project. Additional information on the project was provided by Designer, George Delanuez,

representing the Applicant and Owner, and the Panel directed questions to George Delanuez. ARP members made the following recommendation:

 Modify the design to allow more natural light into the addition (both first and second floor).

The Panel also made the following friendly suggestion (not required):

• Add an architectural element/detail to the structure's wall beneath the new covered porch for more visual interest.

Following the discussion, Panel member Moradi make a motion to approve the project with the above recommendation and friendly suggestion. Vice Chair Mugrdechian-Armen seconded the motion.
