Chapter 8.24 PARK REGULATIONS

Sections:

8.24.010 Title.

The ordinance codified in this chapter is known as "Park Regulations of the City of Calabasas." (Ord. 95-91 § 1, 1995)

8.24.020 Purpose.

To provide guidelines for responsible behavior in all public parks within the city. (Ord. 95-91 \S 2, 1995)

8.24.030 Definitions.

The following definitions are applicable to provisions of this chapter.

"Clean up after your dog" refers to the picking up and disposal of canine fecal matter by the person controlling the animal while at the park.

"Graffiti" is the defacing of surfaces using marking pens, spray paint and other materials.

"Motorized vehicles" are any powered, two-or-more-wheeled vehicles.

"Park hours" are the hours of the day when the park is available and open to the public.

"Radio-controlled devices" are air or ground-based devices powered by batteries, fuel, wind or water.

"Rollerskating and rollerblading" is a means of mobilization using two or four-wheeled skates for transportation or recreation.

"Water feature" refers to a series of cast concrete retention dishes cascading water to a holding pond with a circulation pump system.

8.24.040 Park regulations.

- A. Park hours of operation shall be determined by resolution of the city council.
- B. Dogs are allowed in the parks if kept on a leash. Please be considerate of other park patrons and clean up after your dog.
- C. Motorized vehicles or radio-controlled devices are not allowed in the park. (An exception is motorized wheelchairs and sit-down type carts for disabled individuals.)
- D. Freedom Park. The water feature is a special part of the park experience. Individuals must keep off the structure and pond, and refrain from placing debris, coins, etc. in the waterfall or pond.
- E. All trash and debris must be placed in the appropriate containers.
