US-101 (Between Liberty Canyon Road and LA City Limits) Incident Report

April 2024

For April of 2024 there were a total of 21 reported crashes on US-101. One of the crashes involved a fatality, nine crashes had injuries, and eleven crashes were property damage only. Of those crashes, three involved hit and run drivers and three were due to DUI. In April of 2023 there were 16 reported crashes on US-101. Eight of the crashes had injuries and eight crashes were property damage only. Of those crashes, two involved hit and run drivers and two were due to DUI.

May 2024

For May of 2024 there were a total of 21 reported crashes on US-101. Ten of the crashes had injuries and eleven crashes were property damage only. Of those crashes, five involved hit and run drivers and four were due to DUI. In May of 2023 there were a total of 22 reported crashes on US-101. Eleven of the crashes had injuries and eleven crashes were property damage only. Of those crashes, three involved hit and run drivers and three were due to DUI.

June 2024

For June of 2024 there were a total of 14 reported crashes on US-101. Ten of the crashes had injuries and four crashes were property damage only. Of those crashes, two involved hit and run drivers. There were no DUI related crashes. In May of 2023 there were a total of 13 reported crashes. One of the crashes involved a fatality, three crashes had injuries, and nine crashes were property damage only. Of those crashes, one involved a hit and run driver and one was due to DUI.

General Information

For this reporting period, crashes were caused by unsafe speed for conditions, unsafe turning movements, unsafe lane changes, and DUI.

For crashes, injuries are described as minor, moderate, or major. Most crashes with injuries involve minor injuries such as complaint of pain or minor abrasions and lacerations.

Traffic tends to slow down and backup on US-101 southbound between Lost Hills Road and LA City limits.

The Wallis Annenberg Wildlife Crossing Project has not had a significant impact on traffic in the area.
