

ACTIVITY REPORT FOR MAY 2024  
CALABASAS**

**SCHOOL ISSUES**

The J-Team attended the School Attendance Review Board (SARB) meeting with LVUSD at the District office. The J-Team Sergeant attended the City Schools Committee meeting at Agoura Rec Center to discuss issues and topics within the schools and communities. Additionally, follow-up investigation was conducted regarding a burglary incident at Lupin Hill Elementary. The J-team assisted AC Stelle regarding rumors of possible allegations of 261.5 PC and 401PC. They also assisted Chaparral Elementary School in notifying about a mutual battery incident and assisted Calabasas High School regarding a possible overdose incident where a student was transported to the hospital for medical evaluation.

**INTERVENTIONS**

The J-Team counseled parents and students of Lindero and AE Wright Middle School at the Malibu/Lost Hills Sheriff Station. The students were diverted at the station level and directed to hand-write a report.

The J-team conducted a threat assessment regarding a battery incident at Chaparral Elementary School and a non-viable threat involving an imitation firearm.

The J-team assisted a Special Victims Bureau detective regarding a follow-up on an AE Wright Middle School investigation.

Calabasas High School students were counseled regarding the theft by access card incident.

The J-Team referred a Juvenile student to a diversion program regarding a vandalism case at Gelson's of Calabasas.

**COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES**

1. A Tobacco Sting Operation was conducted by the J-Team for the city of Calabasas.
2. The J-Team Sergeant attended School Safety Assessment Training hosted by JRIC.
3. The J-Team spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question juvenile concerns and community issues. We also provided the parents with resource programs within our community.
4. The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
5. Throughout the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to inform her about our unit's investigations and current issues involving juveniles in our city.
6. The J-team entered juveniles into the Youth Diversion Program for various violations.
7. The J-Team assisted other investigators in preparing court cases and investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office.
8. The J-Team met with station narcotic detectives to exchange information regarding juvenile and drug-related issues.
9. The J-Team handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals regarding various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel brought to the attention of this unit.

10. The J-Team conducted normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
11. The J-Team aided in patrolling for CARP, filled in for any patrol shortages, and worked mandatory overtime.
12. The J-team conducted 290 residential verifications for sex registrants within the city of Calabasas jurisdiction.
