

### **Project Description**

We would like to open a second location of the sushi restaurant, Shibuya. The original Shibuya has been operating in Calabasas for over 20 years. This second location would like to focus mostly on take out orders but will also have sushi counter seating inside along with outdoor tables in the designated area of the plans.

We are applying for this Conditional Use Permit to serve beer, wine and sake at the restaurant. Should we have conditional approval, we will apply for a Type 41 license from the Department of Alcoholic Beverages.

This location's hours of operation will be 11 am to 10 pm, daily with the proposed sale of alcohol during operating hours. We plan on having about 6 to 9 employees.

Our seating capacity is as follows: indoor dining allowed occupant load is 16 occupants, with actual seating provided being 14 seats. The outdoor dining allowed occupant load is 26 occupants, with actual seating provided being 22 seats. Therefore, our total dining allowed occupant load is 42 with 36 actual seating provided.

All beer, wine, and sake will be stored in a refrigerator and/or in a storage area located within the serving area shown on sheet K101 as item K71. There are no beer taps or other features associated with alcohol sales.
