#### LOST HILLS JUVENILE INTERVENTION UNIT ACTIVITY REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 2024 CALABASAS

#### **SCHOOL ISSUES**

- A Calabasas High School student attempted suicide in the school nursing office. The student was transported to the hospital, and an application for a mental health hold was completed.
- Staff Safety Training and a staff safety consultation walkthrough were completed for AE Wright Middle School, Viewpoint School, Calabasas High School, AC Stelle MS, and Bay Laurel Elementary School.
- The J-Team provided security at the Calabasas High School football game.
- A Stanger Danger, 911, and helmet safety presentation was completed at Lupin Hill Elementary School.
- Responded to Calabasas High School for a student allegedly possessing a firearm on campus. After a
  thorough investigation, no firearm was recovered. The informant's statement was also determined to be
  unreliable.
- Two juveniles responsible for starting a small fire in the Calabasas were identified and contacted at AE Wright Middle School. No damage was reported from the fire, and the fire department quickly extinguished it. As a result, the subjects were counseled only. The subjects were receptive to counseling.
- Investigated a social media re-post for a school shooting threat. The post was determined to be unrelated to the Calabasas area. The post was focused on the east San Fernando Valley area.

#### **COMMUNITY / CRIMINAL ISSUES**

- A male adult responsible for burglary and vandalism at AE Wright School was arrested. The criminal report was referred to Van Nuys Court for filing consideration.
- The J-Team spoke with numerous citizens and parents who called to question juvenile concerns and community issues. We also provided the parents with resource programs within our community.
- The J-Team contacted the Sylmar Juvenile Court District Attorney to inquire about the investigation and filing of criminal charges against juvenile offenders.
- Throughout the month, we met with Captain Jennifer Seetoo to inform her about our unit's investigations and current issues involving juveniles in our city.
- The J-Team assisted other investigators in preparing court cases and investigated, prepared, and filed cases with the District Attorney's office.

- The J-Team handled the processing and follow-up of various juvenile referrals regarding various juvenile contacts with uniform personnel brought to the attention of this unit.
- The J-Team conducted normal checks of juvenile problem areas in the city during weekend evenings and responded to juvenile-related calls for service.
- The J-Team aided in patrolling for CARP, filled in for any patrol shortages, and worked mandatory overtime.
- The J-team conducted "290" Residential Verifications for sex registrants within the city of Calabasas jurisdiction.
