BACKGROUND:

The Carl Gibbs Environmental Excellence Award is a symbol of commitment to California's environment. The Award honors a wide array of individuals, businesses, municipalities, government agencies, organizations, institutions, all working to benefit our environment. The Award recognizes voluntary activities by companies and organizations, big or small, private or non-profit, for their environmental activities in the City of Calabasas and in surrounding communities that results in cleaner air or water, less waste, less traffic, conservation of energy and natural resources, efficient and water conserving landscaping, or reduced use of hazardous materials, etc. Furthermore, the Award honors those individuals or organizations that demonstrate exceptional commitment to the environment or innovation above and beyond their primary mission.

DISCUSSION:

Nominations for the Award were submitted by members of the community for consideration by the Commission. The Commission may select multiple recipients for the award and will consider the following for each candidate:

- Measurable improvements to environmental quality

- Ongoing or long-term environmental benefits
- Creativity and innovation in technology or approach
- Model achievements
- Demonstrating a solid commitment to protecting the environment
- Involving employees, governmental officials and/or community members in an environmental project
- Showing a commitment to the public's best interests
- Reaching out in an effective manner to stakeholders
- Taking definitive steps to prevent pollution
- Minimizing costs or demonstrating a payback on investments
