from the Panel. The Panel suggested that whether the roof is new or repaired, that it will match the existing materials. The Panel also mentioned that retrofitting all windows might be necessary to meet new Title 24 standards, and to look into that issue. Furthermore, the Panel also suggested (but not required) to dress up the entry by making the entry a little wider (6" or so) to give the ability to add plants. The Panel recommended approval of the design as is, but to consider the suggested entry modifications.
