## RESOLUTION NO. 2009-1187

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALABASAS TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 2008-1157 AND TO ESTABLISH A CITY-WIDE TRUCK TRACTOR AND TRAILER PARKING PROHIBITION WITH LIMITED EXCEPTIONS

**WHEREAS**, Vehicle Code section 22507 authorizes the City of Calabasas ("City") to prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles on public streets;

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to prohibit the parking of trailers throughout the city and restrict truck tractor parking to certain streets to reduce (i) traffic accidents caused by reduction of lines of sight (ii) deterioration of the neighborhood environment initiated by large vehicle clutter and (iii) noise pollution on the City's roadways; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that this resolution is necessary to protect the public health and safety.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Calabasas as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby rescinds Resolution 2008-1157 which prohibits the parking of any truck tractor and trailers along both sides of Agoura Road and Lost Hills Road within the City.

Section 2. Except as provided in Sections 3 and 4 of this resolution, it shall be unlawful to park any truck tractor, as defined in Vehicle Code section 655, and any trailer, as defined in Vehicle Code section 630, on any street within the City of Calabasas.

Section 3. It shall be allowed to park any truck tractor, as defined in Vehicle Code section 655, along (i) the westside of Valmar Road, between 200 feet and 650 feet south of Mulholland Drive; and (ii) the southside of Thousand Oaks Boulevard, between 200 feet and 500 feet east of Parkmor Road; provided, the following two conditions are satisfied before the owner parks his or her truck tractor on these streets:

1. The owner of the truck tractor is a resident of the City of Calabasas; and,
2. The owner of the truck tractor obtains a permit from the City.

Section 4. This resolution shall not be effective with respect to any commercial vehicle, or trailer component thereof, which are operated for the purpose of (i) making pickups or deliveries of goods, wares, and merchandise from or to any building or structure with the City of Calabasas; or (ii) facilitating the actual and bona fide repair, alteration, remodeling, or construction of any building or structure within the City of Calabasas for which a building permit has previously been obtained.

Section 5. Appropriate signs or markings giving adequate notice of the restrictions provided for in this resolution shall be posted.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause the same to be processed in the manner required by law.
