Here are three ways to search:

1. Basic Search

Type your keyword at the top of the page and press enter. Notice you may then limit your search or type keywords into the "Search Within" results text box on the right side of the screen.



2. Subject Search

If you want to search by subject, click on the dropdown and move the highlighted area to subject. Type a keyword in the text box and a list of possible subjects will be displayed. Choose one and hit the search icon. Articles on that subject will be displayed. Continue your search by typing keywords into the "Search Within" results text box on the right side of the screen.



3. Advanced Search

Select "Advanced Search." Open dialog boxes (buttons with rounded edges) to combine terms and limit your search using keywords, subject, Boolean operators (and, or, not), publication date, etc. Under "More" there is a dictionary, title list, search history and help screen.
