I am respectfully submitting an application to serve on one or more of the following commissions: Environmental Commission, Planning Commission; Parks and Recreation Commission. I was fortunate enough to be involved in the environmental law movement beginning in the late 1970s. Thus, I think I can bring considerable environmental law and land use planning expertise to any of the three commissions listed above.

My family has lived in the same home in the Mulwood Section of Calabasas since February 1987. My wife, Margaret, is very active in Chaparral activities as Treasurer of the Parent Faculty Club and as Vice-President of the Scrip Committee.
