

- * **Pervious Surface:** Portions of a site that remain unpaved or covered with structures after development, including landscaped areas, natural areas; and areas that are paved with permeable paving materials which will allow substantial infiltration of water through the paved surface into the underlying soil. The water surface of a lake, pond or swimming pool <u>is</u> considered pervious. **Permeable paving** may include non-porous paving poured or laid in sections not exceeding one square foot in area and less than two-thirds of the total surface area of the lot.
- *Site Coverage: Site coverage is the percentage of total site area occupied by structures. Site coverage includes the principal structure, all accessory structures (carports, garages, patio covers, storage sheds, trash dumpster enclosures, and other such structures) and architectural features (e.g., chimneys, balconies, decks above the first floor, porches, stairs, etc.). A trellis with a minimum of fifty (50) percent of the roof open is exempt from site coverage calculations. Building coverage is measured from exterior wall.
